SUBJECT: Amendment Concerning the Effectiveness of the Emergency Regulation
Governing the Control and Prevention of COVID-19 – Mandating
Vaccines for Individuals Working and Dining at Indoor Dining Locations.

I have reviewed Amendment Concerning the Effectiveness of the Emergency Regulation Governing the Control and Prevention of COVID-19 – Mandating Vaccines for Individuals Working and Dining at Indoor Dining Locations approved by the Board of Health, a copy of which is attached. I find the regulation to be legal and in proper form. In accordance with Section 8-407(a) of The Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, you may now forward these regulations to the Department of Records where they will be made available for public inspection.

Consistent with Mayor Kenney's March 11, 2020 Declaration of Extraordinary Circumstance: Suspending the Formal Regulatory Process for Regulations Concerning a Novel Coronavirus, you may promulgate the amendment effective immediately upon delivery to the Department of Records as a temporary regulation, while the remaining procedures and formalities of Section 8-407 are followed to promulgate the amendment.
