**PHILADELPHIA DEPARTMENT OF STREETS AMENDED  
REGULATION GOVERNING THE OPERABLE PERIOD OF PLUMBER  
PERMITS**

2.1.13.3 Timing. Plumber permits shall be valid for forty-five (45) days. If a plumber obtains a permit, then determines that the street opening is not needed, the plumber may apply for a refund of the permit purchase price within the forty-five (45) day permit period. No refunds will be issued after the expiration of the plumber permit.
