

Regulation 22 – Leaves of absence

22.14 – FUNERAL LEAVE FOR NON-UNIFORMED NON-REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES. In the event that there is a death in the immediate family of a non-uniformed non-represented employee, consisting only of spouse, spousal equivalent, parents, mother-in-law, father-in-law, children, brother, sister, grandparents, or grandchildren, and the employee attends the funeral service, such employee shall be granted a four (4) days' leave of absence with full pay. A non-uniformed non-represented employee shall be granted one (1) day's absence with pay in the event of a death in the family of such employee other than set forth above, provided the employee attends the funeral service.

22.14.1 BEREAVEMENT LEAVE FOR NON-UNIFORMED DISTRICT COUNCIL 47 REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES. In the event that there is a death in the immediate family of a non-uniformed District Council 47 represented employee, consisting only of spouse, spousal equivalent, stepparents, parents, mother-in-law, father-in-law, children, stepchildren, brother, sister, grandparents, or grandchildren, and the employee attends the funeral service, such employee shall be granted a four (4) days' leave of absence with full pay. A non-uniformed District Council 47 represented employee shall be granted one (1) day's absence with pay in the event of a death in the family of such employee other than set forth above, provided the employee attends the funeral service.
