SUBJECT: Superseding Regulation on the Operation of Temporary Sidewalk Cafes and Streeteries During the COVID-19 Emergency 2021

I have reviewed the attached “Superseding Regulation on the Operation of Temporary Sidewalk Cafes and Streeteries During the COVID-19 Emergency 2021” that was submitted to the Law Department. I find the regulation to be legal and in proper form. In accordance with Section 8-407(a) of The Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, you may forward this regulation to the Department of Records where it will be made available for public inspection.

Consistent with Mayor Kenney’s March 11, 2020 Declaration of Extraordinary Circumstance: Suspending the Formal Regulatory Process for Regulations Concerning a Novel Coronavirus, the regulations may be promulgated immediately upon delivery to the Department of Records as a temporary regulation, while the remaining procedures and formalities of Section 8-407 are followed to permanently promulgate the regulation.
