

DEPARTMENT OF STREETS REGULATION ADDRESSING FEES FOR HAULING PERMITS

Section 1. Purpose. The Philadelphia Department of Streets (“Department”) hereby promulgates the following regulation pursuant to Philadelphia Code Chapter 9, Section 406, Subsection (4), and its police powers under the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, Title V, in order to ensure that the fees for issued permits accurately reflect the cost of administering such programs.

Section 2. Fees for Hauling Permits for Oversized and Overweight Vehicles

2.1 From August 15, 2022 until June 30, 2023, the schedule of application fees for a Hauling Permit for Oversized and Overweight Vehicles shall be:

- \$85.00 for a Standard One-Way, One-Time Move;
- \$170.00 for a Super Load One-Way, One-Time Move;
- \$170.00 for an Impounded Standard One-Way, One-Time Move;
- \$340.00 for an Impounded Super Load One-Way, One-Time Move;

2.2 Starting July 1, 2023 the schedule of application fees for a Hauling Permit for Oversized and Overweight Vehicles shall be:

- \$95.00 for a Standard One-Way, One-Time Move;
- \$190.00 for a Super Load One-Way, One-Time Move;
- \$190.00 for an Impounded Standard One-Way, One-Time Move;
- \$380.00 for an Impounded Super Load One-Way, One-Time Move;

2.3 Varying Rates shall apply to non-standard moves, the cost of which, and authorization for, shall be determined by the Department.

Section 3. Effective Date. These regulations shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication by the Department of Records, absent any request for public comment.
