

Regulation 31 – Interim Regulations

Regulation 31.27 to be established as follows:

31.27 Election Support Special Compensatory Time. Due to the pressing need for workers to perform time-sensitive duties associated with preparing for and holding the upcoming November 2020 election, effective September 1, 2020, any compensatory time earned by employees in non-represented classes ineligible for extra pay for overtime pursuant to Regulation 6.1134 while those employees perform work directed by the City Commissioner’s Office shall be credited to those employees as “special compensatory time.” Special compensatory time shall not count towards the compensatory time accumulation limit contained in Regulation 6.111-8-2. This Regulation does not apply to classes or positions required to earn overtime pay pursuant to the Fair Labor Standards Act.

31.27-1 Election Support Extra Pay. An appointing authority may, at its sole discretion, choose to compensate an employee at the employee’s ordinary rate of pay on an hour-for-hour basis for all or some of the hours of special compensatory time earned pursuant to this Regulation instead of crediting the employee with such time.
