



**CITY OF PHILADELPHIA  
DEPARTMENT OF STREETS**

**Regulations Governing Fees And Charges For Various Permitted Activities Under  
Sections 11-106, 11-203, 11-605, 11-610, 11-611 and 11-804 of The Philadelphia Code**

Fees are hereby established for permits issued pursuant to authority granted in The Philadelphia Code ("the Code") as follows:

**Section 1. Definitions.**

A. Center City. Means the area bounded by Spring Garden Street, the Delaware River, South Street, and the Schuylkill River, including all parts of the boundary streets.

B. University City. Means the area bounded by the Schuylkill River to the east, Spring Garden Street from the Schuylkill River to 40<sup>th</sup> Street, 40<sup>th</sup> Street from Spring Garden to Powelton Avenue, Powelton Avenue from 40<sup>th</sup> Street to Market Street, Market Street from Powelton Avenue to 50<sup>th</sup> Street, 50<sup>th</sup> Street from Market Street to Springfield Avenue, Springfield Avenue from 50<sup>th</sup> Street to 49<sup>th</sup> Street, 49<sup>th</sup> Street from Springfield Avenue to Woodland Avenue, Woodland Avenue from 49<sup>th</sup> Street to 45<sup>th</sup> Street, 45<sup>th</sup> Street from Woodland Avenue extended to the Schuylkill River, including all parts of the boundary streets.

**Section 2. Permit Fees for Breaking Streets and Footways Under Code Section 11-203.**

A. Fees for permits to break open streets and footways pursuant to section 11-203(7) of the Code are as follows:

1. Paved Street -- \$500 for the first two square yards plus \$120 for each additional square yard or portion thereof.
2. Historical Street -- \$950 per opening.
3. Unpaved Street -- \$50 per opening.
4. Footway -- \$25 per opening.

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**Section 3. Permit Fees for Placing Construction Materials in the Roadway Under Code Section 11-605.**

- A. Fees for permits to place construction materials in the roadway pursuant to Code section 11-605 are \$1.00 per linear foot of occupancy per week, with a minimum fee of \$40 per week.
- B. Occupancy for any period of time less than seven days shall be charged as a full week.

**Section 4. Permit Fees for Placing Construction Equipment in the Roadway Under Code Section 11-610.**

A. Fees for permits to place construction equipment in the roadway pursuant to Code section 11-610 are as follows:

- 1. Construction Dumpsters. For permits to place a construction dumpster, the fee shall be \$40 per week.
- 2. Partial Street Closures. For permits requesting the closure or occupancy of sidewalks, parking lanes or travel lanes (including bike lanes), due to the placement maintenance of all other construction equipment, fees are based on per linear foot closure or occupancy/per week. The minimum weekly fee per type of closure block \$50 and the maximum annual fee per type of closure is \$90,000. For full sidewalk closures, the minimum weekly fee per block will be \$200 after the first week.

\* Please note, it is possible to have several types of closure on one block. In these instances, the maximum yearly fee will be \$90,000 per type of closure.

3. Full Street Closures. Permit fees for full street closures shall be charged as follows:

a. For closures associated with helicopter lifts, the fee shall be \$275 for a permit of up to six hours for up to ten blocks, plus \$60 per each block in excess of ten blocks.

b. For all other permits for periods of five days or less, the fee shall be \$250 per day per block with any period of less than twenty-four hours charged as a full day.

c. For any period in excess of five days, the following fees shall be charged on a per week, per block basis as set forth below. The maximum annual fee per block per year is \$90,000 in Center City & University City, and \$30,000 in all other areas:

B. For fees charged on a per week basis, closure or occupancy for any period of time less than seven days shall be charged as a full week.

C. For fees charged on a per block basis, full closure of a portion of a block constitute closure of the entire block.

**Section 5. Permit fees for Temporary Street Closures Under Code Section 11-611.**

A. Fees for permits to temporarily close sidewalks, parking lanes or travel lanes (including bike lanes) due to building maintenance, loading or unloading or related activities pursuant to section 11-611 of the Code shall be as follows:

1. "Temporary No Parking Signs." The permit fee under this subsection shall be charged on a daily basis as set forth below. A maximum requirement of forty linear feet shall be posted. The maximum posting duration shall be forty-eight hours.

2. Partial sidewalk closures for periodic window washing. The permit fee under this subsection shall be \$150 per block per year.

3. All other permit fees under section 11-611 shall be based on per linear foot of closure or occupancy/ per week. The minimum weekly fee per type of closure block is \$50 and the maximum annual fee per type of closure is \$90,000. For full sidewalk closures, the minimum weekly fee per block will be \$200 after the first full week.

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B. For permits charged on a weekly basis, closure or occupancy for any period of time less than seven days shall be charged as a full week.

**Section 6. Permit Fees for Placement of Portable On-Demand Storage Units (PODS) Under Code Section 11-804.**

The fee for a permit to place a POD in the public right-of-way pursuant to section 11-804 of the Code shall be \$50.

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**Section 7. Supplemental Inspection Fees Under Code Section 11-106.**

A. If an activity requires a permit or action by the Department under Title 11 of the Code for which a fee or charge is established by regulation, and the activity is carried out before such permit or action by the Department is obtained, the person or persons responsible for obtaining such a permit or action shall pay, in addition to the permit fee or other charge, an inspection fee equal to the amount of the permit fee or other charge, in order to obtain the permit or action by the Department.

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Note: These Regulations shall go into effective immediately upon publication by the Records Department.
