RE: AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS OF THE MANAGING DIRECTOR'S
OFFICE REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A ROTATIONAL
TOWING SYSTEM AND RELATED TOWING REQUIREMENTS
PURSUANT TO SECTION 9-605(4) OF THE PHILADELPHIA CODE

On May 17th, 2019, the Managing Director's Office proposed amendments to its "Regulations Regarding the Establishment of a Rotational Towing System and Related Towing Requirements Pursuant to Section 9-605(4) of The Philadelphia Code." These amendments were properly filed with the Department of Records on that date.

However, it has subsequently come to my attention that a technical error had not permitted a full copy of the proposed amended regulations to be accessible online for the complete duration of the public inspection period.

Although the technical issue has since been rectified, and the amendments have since been made available online, it is the intent of the Managing Director's Office to ensure that the proposed amendments are fully accessible to the public for inspection for the entire time period mandated by the Home Rule Charter.

Therefore, I am respectfully requesting that the proposed amendments to the regulations that were filed on May 17th be withdrawn.
